Boarding/Grooming-

The Inn at Wolftever takes all precautions to ensure your pet is happy and safe during its boarding stay with us. Even with the best of care boarding can be stressful due to the change in environment and their normal daily routine. There are a few common medical conditions that can occur while boarding which can include but not limited to:

- Stomach Upset/Diarrhea
- Coughing/Sneezing
- Hot Spot/Skin Irritation/Ear Infections
- Kennel Nose/Paw/Tail

Elderly pets tend to have a much more difficult time during the boarding process than younger healthier animals. Intact male dogs also tend to be at an increased risk for scrotal irritation.

If any of these or other conditions do occur a courtesy examination will be performed by one of our veterinarians. If the pet has left our facility, we must be notified of any issues within 24 hours of boarding, daycare, or grooming to receive a courtesy examination.

Doggy Daycare-

The Inn at Wolftever takes all precautions to ensure your pet is happy and safe during Doggy Daycare. Doggy Daycare is a great way to socialize your pet while burning off extra energy during our group play sessions. While in group play sessions injuries do occur on rare occasions. If any injury occurs a courtesy examination will be performed by one of our veterinarians.

If any medical condition occurs with your pet The Inn staff will notify you immediately. If we cannot get in touch with you, our veterinary team will assess the situation and provide necessary treatments and medications to your pet.
